

‘Exemptions from wearing face masks’

Face coverings have been compulsory on public transport in England since 15 June. From July 24, it will also be compulsory to wear a face covering in shops in England. Certain people are exempt including:

- children under 11
- people with disabilities
- those with breathing difficulties
- anyone travelling with someone who relies on lip reading

Shop workers will also be exempt

People who fail to comply with the rules face a fine of up to £100
