Ear Care Service

- *Acute ear care problems
 - *Treatment of wax
- Certain pharmacists are trained. Please ask at reception for your nearest pharmacy.

Eye Care Service

- *Red/pink eye
- *Itchy/Gritty/Sore/Burning eyes
- *Dry eyes
- *Watery/mucky eyes
- *Eyelid lumps and styles
- *Foreign body on the eye
- *Mild pain/discomfort in eye
- *Flashing lights/Floaters
- *Ingrowing eyelash
- *Blurred/Distorted vision

Dental Problems

If you have any dental/jaw/tooth problems then you will need to contact your dentist or 111 for treatment and medication. GPs are unable to treat a dental abscess.

Primary care networks have added an additional 160 hours of GP and Nurse and have made these available over 5 different locations, these are:

- *Tichkill Surgery *Conisborough Group Practice
- *Lakeside Surgery *Same Day Health Centre
- *Thornmoor Medical Centre (Thorne)

You can be seen at these extra appointment through the week and also on a Saturday. At the “hubs” there will be GPs, Advanced nurse practitioners, & healthcare assistants. Receptionists will be happy to book you a suitable appointment.

Online Services—What can you access?

You can sign up to use our online service and will be able to access the following:

- * Book/cancel and change appointments (GP, Nurse & HCA)
- * Order your medication
- * View your medical record
- * View your test results
- * Service announcements for health news

You are able to assign a named Proxy user with consent to allow parents to book for children (under 13) and also for other family members to have access to information, again with consent.



Did you know that you can have your height, weight, blood pressure and pulse checked in surgery without an appointment. Ask the receptionist for a token.
